**The 2011 ITTF PTT Asian and Oceanic Regional Table Tennis Championships for the Disabled
Hong Kong players perform well**

The 2011 ITTF PTT Asian and Oceanic Regional Table Tennis Championships for the Disabled kicked off today (17 December) at Ma On Shan Sports Centre. Most of the top seeded players performed well as well as the Hong Kong representatives.

In the Men's Singles (Class Three), Hong Kong's Ko Hang Yee, who won a bronze medal in the 2010 Guang Zhou Asian Para Games, reached his peak to win two from two in his round robin. He will play Japan's Nabesaka Isao in the quarter final which will be held at 10am tomorrow (18 December). Teammate Choi Siu Hung also entered the quarter finals, and will face China's Zhao Ping.

In addition, China's Feng Panfeng, who is ranked first, showed his masterful skills to edge out Hong Kong's Choi Siu Hung and Chinese Taipei's Yin Chien Ping. He will next meet Korea's Kim Jin Sung.

Team China is hoping to get the extra tickets to the 2010 London Paralympics Games and they are represented by more than 30 athletes including six top seeds such as Feng Panfeng.

In the Men's Singles (Class Nine), Ma Lin underlined his strength when beating Hong Kong's Wong Chi Yin 11-3, 11-2, 11-5 before outplaying another opponent in the second match of the competition, Malaysia's Hong Chin Sing, by the same margin.

In the Women's Singles (Class Four), Zhou Ying easily beat her rivals from Jordan and Chinese Taipei.

In the Women's Singles (Class Five), Chinese Taipei's Wei Mei Hui gave lots of pressure to World No.1 Gu Gai but the latter managed to win 10-12, 11-6, 11-5, 10-12, 11-8.
